

BARGAINING PROCESS AND TIME LINES (Canada Labour Code) Revised to Accommodate the 30 day Extension

Sequence:

If Conciliator does not book-out prior to 60 days from appointment, he/she is deemed to have reported and booked-out 60 days after appointment (S.75.2)

Calendar Time Line: *Before the 30 day extension the 60 days was due to expire on December 18, 2007. With the 30 day extension the date is now January 18, 2008.*

21 days thereafter, the Parties are in a legal strike/lock-out position. (S. 89(d))

Calendar Time Line: *21 days following January 18th is February 08, 2008.*

Strike/lock-out 72 hour notice must be served (S. 87.2) Parties may then legally strike or lock-out.

Calendar Time Line: *Expiry of 72 hours notice is February 11, 2008 before either party can strike or lockout. .*
