



# Bulk Operator's Training

---

## Training Program Outline

### Goal

Using equipment control panels and computer screens, trainees will be able to operate bulk handling machinery and equipment to ship and receive different bulk commodities at the Kinder Morgan Canada, Pacific Coast, Neptune, and Fibreco terminals, following established safety measures and precautions, and operating procedures for each piece of equipment.

### Program Description

This training program includes classroom instruction and site specific training as well as written and practical examination.

Through classroom instruction, trainees develop foundational knowledge of the bulk operator's role and responsibilities, general safety rules and procedures, and common bulk handling equipment components and operating techniques. Building on this foundation, trainees develop site specific safety knowledge in addition to knowledge of the special features, control panels and computer screens of the bulk handling equipment they will use at each site.

Operational skills are developed through participation in site specific equipment training and trainees are expected to achieve an established standard of performance for the operating procedures of each piece of equipment.



## Pre-requisites

### Educational

### Experiential

Experience as a bulk labourer, and with computers, is an asset.

### Medical

- Pass the industry pre-placement medical examination administered by a BCMEA approved physician.
- Pass an eye examination conducted by a doctor of the trainee's choosing. Candidate must possess adequate colour perception and be able to differentiate red/green.

### Working Conditions

- Climb stairs and ladders
- Tolerate dusts (wood, coal, sulphur, potash, agricultural)
- Work at heights and in enclosed spaces.

Classroom and on-the-job training
