



Compressor Car Shuttle Wagon

Training Program Outline

Goal

Trainees will be able to operate the compressor car and shuttle wagon, following established safety precautions and practices, and operating procedures.

Program Description

In this training program that combines classroom instruction with hands-on training, trainees develop knowledge of general safety precautions and practices in addition to knowledge of equipment components, controls and operating procedures. Operating skills are developed through hands-on training and practice and trainees are expected to meet an established standard of performance for each operating task including pre-start inspection, start-up, applying service air (compressor car), disengaging from train (compressor car), general operations, unhooking from rail cars (shuttle wagon), dismounting from rails (shuttle wagon), and shut-down.
