



Dozer

Training Program Outline

Goal

Trainees will be able to operate the dozer following established safety precautions and practices and operating procedures to push, shear, cut, and roll material ahead of the tractor at the Neptune and Fibreco terminals and on vessels transporting salt and sugar.

Program Description

In this training program that combines classroom instruction with hands-on training, trainees develop knowledge of general safety precautions and practices in addition to knowledge of communication methods and procedures, the role and responsibilities of the dozer operator, dozer equipment components and controls, characteristics and handling issues of different material types, and operating concepts and procedures.

Through demonstration and practice, trainees develop operational skills. Trainees are expected to pass a written quiz and to demonstrate an established performance level of performance for each operating procedure including pre-start inspection, safe travelling, operating the blade, setting up a pile, pushing cargo in and out, parking the dozer, and shutdown.
