



Lashing

Training Program Outline

Goal

Using the appropriate tools and equipment, trainees will be able to lash and unlash containers correctly and efficiently, following established safety precautions and practices and lashing procedures, to maintain container stability onboard vessels.

Program Description

In this training program that combines classroom instruction with hands-on training, trainees develop knowledge of the lasher's job in addition to general lashing safety hazards and safe working practices for working around containers. Trainees also become familiar with the types of container damage, the different lashing gear and equipment, and the safe operating practices to be observed at the start of the shift and while working on deck and aloft. Lashing and unlashng skills are developed through hands-on training and practice in a controlled environment.
