



Mobile Crane Operator

Training Program Outline

Goal

Trainees will be able to operate mobile cranes at the Canada Place and Ballantye Pier terminals, following established safety precautions and practices, and operating procedures.

Program Description

In this training program that combines classroom instruction with hands-on training, trainees develop knowledge of general safety policies and procedures, the mobile crane operator's role and responsibilities, equipment components, controls & safety devices, and safe operating rules and concepts (maintaining crane stability). Operating skills are developed through demonstration and practice, and trainees are expected to demonstrate an established performance level for each operating technique and procedure including pre start-up inspection, setting-up of mobile crane adjacent to vessel, lowering stabilizers and crabbing near bullrail, hooking up cage, parking the mobile crane, and shut-down.
