



Red Dog Crane/120 Unloader Operator Training

Training Program Outline

Goal

Trainees will be able to complete a pre-operation inspection and perform procedures related to start-up, general operation, equipment moving and shut-down using the HMI system and following established safety rules and precautions and equipment operating procedures.

Program Description

Using a combination of classroom instruction and on site training, this program provides trainees with knowledge of the external and HMI system equipment components in addition to safety concerns and responsibilities. Trainees develop operating skills through hands-on equipment training in the work environment. At the completion of the program, trainees are expected to successfully complete a knowledge-based assessment and to demonstrate an established standard of performance for each operational skill, including pre-operation inspection, selecting a route, starting the crane, working around hatch coamings, adjusting the hopper gate opening and removing the excavator or dozer from the ship's hold.
