



Standard Checker

Training Program Outline

Goal

Trainees will be able to perform the operational duties of the standard checker in tracking the movement of container traffic at the Lynnterm, Neptune, PCT, Coastwise and Vanterm terminals following established general and site specific safety practices and precautions and checking procedures.

Program Description

This training program combines classroom instruction with hands-on training and written and practical examination.

Trainees develop knowledge of the duties and responsibilities of the standard checker, safety procedures and precautions, container types, components and labelling of standard containers, cargo identification, and procedures for destuffing and stuffing containers, railcars or trailers and inspecting different cargo types.

Skills in completing standard checker procedures are developed through hands-on site specific training and trainees are expected to demonstrate a minimum performance standard for each checking procedure.
