## **BULLETIN** **WORKING PAST AGE 65**

Further to the Union's bulletin dated August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010, this bulletin is to advise you that a joint policy has not been signed by the Union which would allow employees to continue working past age 65.

A draft "Working Past Age 65" policy was tabled with the Union last week and we have asked the Union for their position on this policy, to date we have not received a response.

We are unable to move forward until such time as all the elements of the policy outlining the terms and conditions of members continuing to work past age 65 have been agreed upon and signed by both parties.

We feel it is important that employees who wish to continue working past age 65 make a decision with full knowledge and understanding of the effect that decision has on the terms and conditions of their employment.
